Collection for the New Saint Charles Seminary

Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary has educated the priests of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia since 1832 and the priests from the Diocese of Allentown since 1961.

Six years ago, the Archdiocese made the decision, after a long study and much prayer, to move the site of Saint Charles Seminary to the campus of Gwynedd Mercy College, in North Wales, PA. The current buildings at Saint Charles were built to serve a seminary enrollment of 600! The current enrollment is 150. Even when I was a student there from 1990 to 1996 and the enrollment was 250, many of the areas in each building were unused and to save funds, were not maintained. The move to Gwynedd Mercy College will necessitate the construction of two new buildings for the seminary's use and the repurposing of an already existing, but unused dormitory. While located on the campus of Gwynedd Mercy College, the Seminary will remain an independent college with its own charter from the Commonwealth of Pennsvlvania.

To assist with this construction and move, Bishop Schlert has asked that a special **one-time** collection be taken up in all the parishes in the Diocese of Allentown, on the weekend of November 4-5. Saint Charles Borromeo's feast day is November 4th.

There will not be a special envelope for this collection. If you want to have your donation recorded for tax purposes, please place it in an envelope marked with you name.

Saint Peter Parish has been well served by many priests who attended Saint Charles Seminary over the years. In their memory and in gratitude for them, I personally ask you to be generous to this collection.
