

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the parish priest at least 1 year but no later than 6 months prior to the intended wedding date. Weddings are on Saturday between 10A.M. and 1P.M.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Notify the rectory when someone becomes seriously ill, or weak due to old age, so that the person might receive this Sacrament.

COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND: The Pastor & Deacon perform this visit monthly on the 1sr Friday of the month. Notify us when someone wishes to be visited.

HOSPITALIZED: Alert us whenever someone has to be hospitalized, especially when their admission is an emergency. The parish identification number is #171.



GUEST SPEAKER: STEVE JAVIE

Deacon Steve Javie was born and raised in the Philadelphia area. He attended LaSalle High School in Philadelphia and graduated in 1972. Javie attended Temple University in Philadelphia where he played baseball for four years and graduated with a business degree in 1976. After a brief stint in the minor leagues, Steve's focus turned to officiating, and was hired to referee in the CBA, the minor league for the NBA. After five years in the minor leagues, Steve was hired by the NBA in 1986 where he officiated for 25 years.

During his career, Steve officiated over 1,400 regular season games, 240 playoff games, 23 finals games and two All Star games. After his career in the NBA, Steve wanted to serve the Catholic church and felt a calling to become a Deacon. In 2012, he attended St. Charles Sentingri in Philadelphia where he would be in formation for the next seven years. In 2019, Steve was ordained a Deacon in the Catholic Church by Philadelphia Archbishop, Charles Chaput. He and his wife Maryellen currently reside in Newtown and he is assigned to St. Andrew Parish in Newtown PA.


