

MARRIAGE: Couples should contact the parish priest at least 1 year but no later than 6 months prior to the intended wedding date. Weddings are on Saturday between 10A.M. and 1P.M.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Notify the rectory when someone becomes seriously ill, or weak due to old age, so that the person might receive this Sacrament.

COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND: The Pastor & Deacon perform this visit monthly on the 1sr Friday of the month. Notify us when someone wishes to be visited.

HOSPITALIZED: Alert us whenever someone has to be hospitalized, especially when their admission is an emergency. The parish identification number is #171.



October 7, 2025 Memorial of the Most Holy Rosary

Dear Parishioners,

The parish financial year ended on June 30, 2025. With the guidance of the parish finance committee, I am happy to present to you a summary of parish's financial status at the end of fiscal year. The summary is on the reverse side of this letter and will also be published in the quarterly parish newsletter, Saint Peter Parish Post. Your generosity throughout the year makes it possible for our parish to function and to continue to proclaim the gospel message. The many spiritual activities that Saint Peter's undertakes each year are made possible because of your financial commitment to the parish.

We are fortunate to have very dedicated and stalwart members of the financial committee. George Kinek, Allen Edelman, and Frank Marth, and Kathy Betz, along with Michelle Ahern, our parish financial secretary, keep a keen eye on parish finances. They assist in reviewing spending and fundraising, the parish and cemetery investments, and the various capital improvements that keep the parish facilities in good shape. I would also like to thank Lina Abi-Samra, parish secretary, for keeping the rectory office running with the many duties of producing the weekly bulletin, keeping the parish calendar, keeping track of the members, and, most of all, keeping my calendar, which is no easy

task, and many thanks to Larry Tellup, who oversees the physical plant.

During the past fiscal year, we welcomed the Evangelizing Sisters of Mercy to our parish convent. Because of your generosity over the years, we were able to renovate the convent. I want to also thank the members of the Altar and Rosary Society for providing the furnishings for the renovated rooms in the convent. The renovations to the convent were the most significant capital improvement made to the parish facilities in the last fiscal year. Because of some issues that we did not anticipate at the beginning of the project, the overall cost of the renovations was more than we planned for and resulted in the budget deficit you will see on the reverse side of this letter. Thankfully, we had the funds on hand to fully fund the deficit and since that time, the parish investments have grown so that deficit has been repaid.

During the same period of time, the parish welcomed 12 new souls through the Sacrament of Baptism. 5 children received their First Holy Communion, and 7 children were confirmed. There were 6 weddings in the parish. The Sacrament of the Sick was administered to 63 persons. 39 parishioners passed away. We added a number of persons to the homebound list, so that with the assistance of Deacon Kudla, 22 persons are visited on a monthly basis.

This past fiscal year was also significant in that it was the first year that Saint Peter Parish shared a pastor with Saint John the Baptist Parish. This twinning means that Saint Peter is responsible for only ½ of the pastor's salary and benefits. Overall, thanks to your cooperation, this transition has gone very smoothly. The most common comment that I have heard is that the Masses are full again.

As we continue on, please continue to be as generous to the parish as you can through your weekly contributions and perhaps increase it if you can. Please continue to support our fundraising events. Your contributions, prayers, and volunteer efforts will continue us to help proclaim the Gospel. May God bless you and your families.
