Recently, the Diocese of Allentown recognized the SPHNS for significantly increasing its membership.

Our members are committed not only to honoring the Holy Names of Jesus and God, but also to supporting the parish of St. Peter. Each year, we visit parish shut-ins and provide them with gift cards for Giant grocery store. We also acknowledge the altar servers with a monetary gift on the last Sunday of each month.



The St. Peter Confraternity of the Most Holy Names of God and Jesus (Holy Name Society) is dedicated to promoting reverence for the Sacred Names of God and Jesus Christ. The Holy Name Society is an official organization recognized by the Diocese of Allentown.

The Society's financial support comes from our hoagie sales, which are held three times per year.

We contribute to the parish in many ways, including serving as members of the pierogi team, choir, finance council and parish council; Sunday envelope counters, ushers, St. Peter Festival Picnic organizers and workers, DMI committee members, cantors, lectors, Knights of Columbus and Eucharistic ministers.

Each month, we hold a Mass to honor deceased members of the SPHNS. Our monthly meetings take place immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass offered for the Society. All men of the parish are invited to join.

Carlo Acutis Prep

The St. Carlo Acutis Regional Parish Religious Education Program (PREP), is dedicated to forming young disciples who are connected to Christ and wired for heaven. Classes are conducted at the Blessed Carlo Acutis Catholic Education Center, 3008 Ruch St., Whitehall. The program runs from September to the end of April. These classes are necessary for eligibility to receive the Sacraments of Penance, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

In The Works... Capital Improvements

AIR CONDITIONING UPGRADE

The Parish Finance Committee recently completed a competitive bid process to upgrade the church air conditioning system. The existing cooling tower chiller was reaching the end of its useful life, and we had difficulty getting spare parts to keep it running.

The scope of work will include:

- Removal and replacement of the cooling tower chiller behind the church
- Replacing the chilled water pump and associated valves, pressure gauges, thermometer, piping systems and electrical power distribution system in the boiler room
- Installing a glycol feeding system
- Provide a variable frequency drive system for the air handlers that serve the church sanctuary
- Fixing leaking piping and insulation in the church social hall.

The variable frequency drive system will stop the screeching sound the air conditioning system makes when it calls for cooling inside the church.

We hired CHA Consulting, Inc. to help us develop the scope of work, evaluate the bids and provide technical support for installation and start-up of the equipment.

The competitive bid process took place Sept./Oct. 2025. We solicited 5 bidders and received three competitive bids. Evaluating the bids for technical and commercial compliance took place Oct./Nov. We secured approval from the Diocese of Allentown Capital Improvement Committee and the Diocese of Allentown Council of Priests Committee during Nov./Dec. to proceed with the project. After incorporating the comments from the Diocese, we contracted with ASL Mechanical, Inc, of Catasauqua, Pa., the low bidder, in December.

The new Cooling Tower and associated work will take place April/May of 2026.

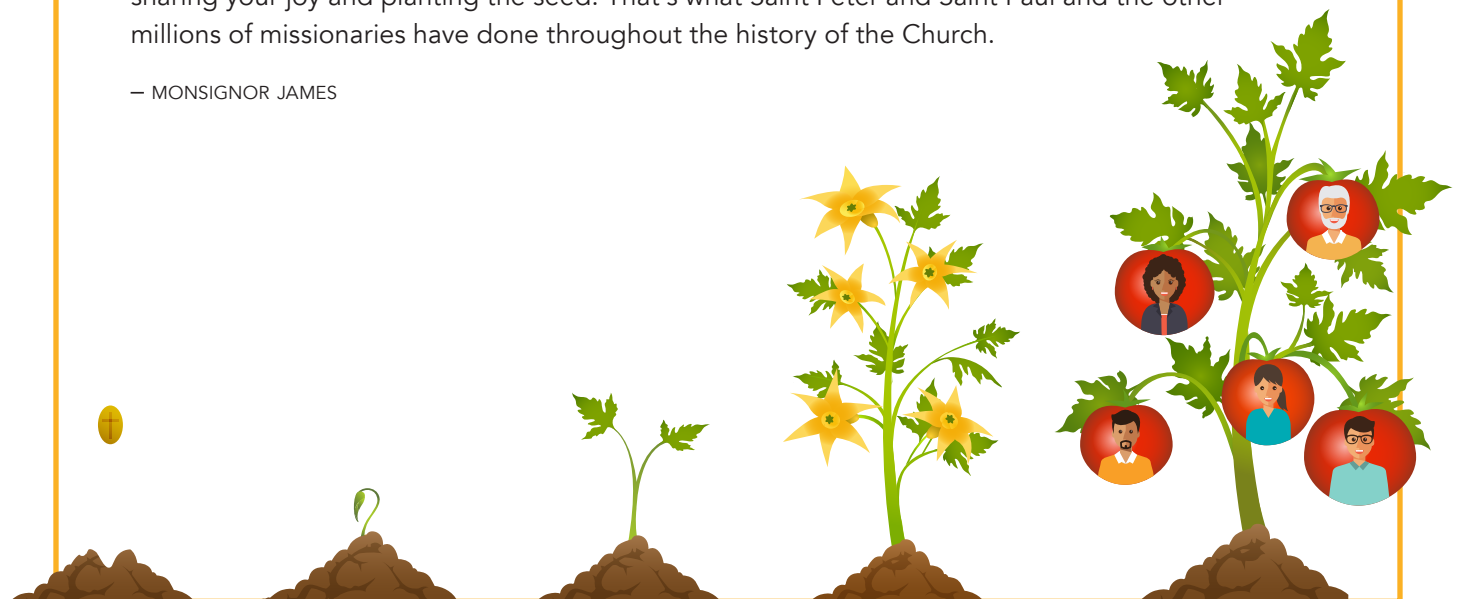
One of the goals for this year is to reach out to those members of the parish who no longer attend Mass or participate in the life of the parish. We need to enlist your help. While the Committee envisions one-on-one contact with inactive members, we need you to plant the seed.

HOW CAN YOU DO THIS?

- First, if you have a family member who no longer participates, please invite them to come back, even if it is only for Ash Wednesday or for Easter.
- Second, keep them informed of what is happening at St. Peter Parish, not just about fundraising but about the opportunities to pray together or to reach out to help those in need. Provide them with a bulletin.
- Third, if you have a neighbor or family member who can no longer attend Mass because of age or infirmity, please let us know. Sadly, many older parishioners become hospitalized, and we don't know about them because of HIPPA regulations, and when they return home can no longer attend Mass. We don't want them to think that we have forgotten about them or don't care.
- Fourth, share the joy that you experience when you attend Mass, receive the sacraments, or participate in some parish activity. Watching Mass on television pales in comparison to the great joy and grace we receive when we participate in the Mass and receive Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

Spring is soon upon us. When your mind turns to planning your vegetable and flower seeds, remember to plant a seed of faith in the fertile ground of a soul who is no longer attending Mass. You might be surprised at the beautiful flower of faith and the harvest of charity that your one little seed can produce in the soul of another. This is the secret of evangelization – you sharing your joy and planting the seed. That's what Saint Peter and Saint Paul and the other millions of missionaries have done throughout the history of the Church.

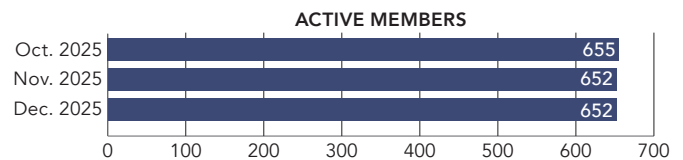
